Master Plan Vision Discussion

- Reviewed vision / schematic (conceptual) plans prepared by HMA2 Architects
 - Trustee Edwards noted elements within the children's space and young adult space need more design attention
 - o Trustee Malina raised concerns about the proposed outdoor spaces
 - Pergola: Functionality, design-fit with existing building, not enclosed
 - Amphitheater: Liability of people falling / gathering after library hours
- It was agreed a need does exist for outdoor space
 - o Perhaps simplified alternatives for outdoor space are best
- Current design offers flexibility, optimizes existing space, compliments architecture
- Amphitheater and pergola are bonus elements
- Functional elements are all great, thoughtful, and creatively optimize existing structure
- Budget was a topic of concern, Trustee Riina expressed potential budget to be approximately \$12 Million for full plan which includes estimated soft costs, hard costs, escalations, and staging.
- Trustee Edwards acknowledged the project represents a broader community impact beyond the library itself a future positive impact we may not be capturing if we forego the full design package.

Trustee Myers moved for adjournment at 8:14 pm, seconded by Trustee Malina.
