PRESCHOOL TIME Ages: 2½ – 5 Years

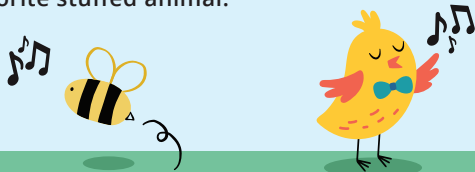
11:00 – 11:30 AM
